2. RELIGIOUS LIBERTY



Defend the right of Muslims - and people of all faiths - to live their faith be that in religious clothing, food and reasonable accommodation of religious observance.

3. BIGOTRY



Combat Islamophobia, anti-Semitism, anti-migrant sentiment and all forms of racism on our streets, online and in our media.

4. DEMOCRACY FOR ALL



Enhance our democracy by increasing participation of minorities and women in politics and public life.

5. SECURITY AND FREEDOM



Uphold civil liberties and re-build trust with communities when tackling crime and terrorism. Demand an independent review of Prevent.

6. EQUALITY IN EDUCATION



Develop an inclusive National Curriculum reflecting the diverse religious, ethnic and cultural identity of Britain today. Promise a fair and equal approach to educational provision be that in faith schools or in state schools with large Muslim populations.

7. FREE PALESTINE



Support a binding recognition of Palestine as an independent and sovereign state.

8. ETHICAL FOREIGN POLICY



Uphold an ethical and consistent UK foreign policy with human rights, poverty alleviation and justice.
